Dear Parents and Carers,

**Re: AS Maths**

As you may be aware, this week I asked a colleague from the Education Achievement Service to speak to students and look at books with students in AS Maths. As a result, she identified some areas of student concerns, and actions for the school to implement.

The following has been put in place:

1. Mr Jones will be delivering an additional hour of supported revision for statistics on a Monday after school;
2. There will be an Easter revision session for statistics on Tuesday, 10<sup>th</sup> April, 9am – 12midday;
3. All AS teachers are working with their classes to identify gaps in knowledge or understanding in order to focus their teaching, revision and support after Easter;
4. Past exam questions for each statistics topic will be made available for students so that they can practise exam question on topics and consolidate their learning. These will be marked by the teacher;
5. Exam papers will be provided to ensure that students are able to identify the topics where this is not flagged by the teacher, in order to give them confidence identifying which topic they are covering in the exam.

Since there are only two past papers available for the new examination specification, students may be given papers from old specifications too. Where this is the case, questions which are not part of the new spec will be crossed out by the teacher beforehand.
