Homework is set once a week and students have a minimum of one week to complete this. Homework is intended to enhance and enrich class based learning, and will involve a number of different types of task. In some subjects students will be able to select tasks to do. Teachers will encourage students to choose stretching tasks, making challenging choices for their homework.

I hope that you will support your child in this. Sometimes students may be asked to complete unfinished class work at home, or to revise for tests. This will be in addition to the homework tasks set.

Maths homework will be given on a Monday each week; English homework will be given on a Tuesday.

Other subjects will set homework on a day of the week on which their lesson falls.
