Young Carers at Chepstow School

At Chepstow School, we recognise that some of our learners take on significant responsibilities at home as **Young Carers**. A Young Carer is a child under 18 who regularly helps to look after a family member who is disabled, ill, experiencing mental ill health, or living with an addiction.

Young Carers may be involved in tasks such as:

- Practical support cooking, housework, shopping
- Physical care lifting or helping someone move around
- **Personal care** assisting with dressing, washing, or toileting
- Managing household responsibilities budgeting, collecting prescriptions
- Administering medication
- Caring for younger siblings
- Supporting communication

When these responsibilities become a necessity rather than a choice, we consider the learner a Young Carer. Research suggests there are over 800,000 Young Carers in the UK, yet many do not realise they fall into this role.

- **Morning check-**in to ensure our Young Carer has the necessary equipment, knows their timetable, and feels supported and ready to learn
- **Enhanced Transition** programmes to ease key school changes
- Young Carers Week and Action Day to raise awareness and educate our school community
- **Staff training** so every teacher understands how to support Young Carers with workload, adaptive learning, and emotional wellbeing
- Pastoral care, small group workshops, and enrichment opportunities
- Strong links with the local Young Carers Service for additional support beyond school
